Below, you will find information about our learning for Term 4. We hope this will help you to support your child at home, especially with home learning. PSHE

We will be learning about using the internet and keeping safe online. We will also be learning about our strengths and interests and those of others, as well as different jobs in the community.

DT

We will be learning about where foods come from. Children will explore different ingredients and develop skills including; spreading, mixing, whisking, crushing, rubbing and kneading.

Science

Our focus areas are:

- Animals
- Seasons/ seasonal changes

RE

We will be focusing on Christianity; learning about community, worship and celebration.

PE

We will be focusing on ball skills, developing skills including rolling and catching.

Maths

Our focus areas are:

- Place value within 50
- Ordering numbers within 50
- Length and height
- Mass and volume

Computing

We will be continuing learning to write short algorithms and program floor robots to make them move.

Geography

We will continue learning about the four countries and capital cities in the UK. We will also look at seasonal weather patterns in the UK.

English

Phonics will continue to be taught daily, focusing on developing blending and segmenting skills to support reading and writing. Children will be exposed to a range of texts through reading sessions with an adult linked to their phonics learning, as well as daily whole-class story time

In English, we will be looking at narrative texts. Writing will focus on the essentials of capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and joining sentences with 'and', as well as improving sentences.
