Dear parents and carers,

To link with our learning about growing, we have arranged for the children in Foundation Stage to visit Sacrewell Farm, near Peterborough, next term. Whilst there, they will be able to enjoy hands-on experiences of where their food comes from, including butter making and exploring growing in the gardens. The day will then be completed with visiting some farm animals, a picnic lunch and, of course, exploring the adventure playground!

Please send your child wearing their school uniform for the trip, with comfortable and practical footwear. Weather depending, please make sure your child brings a waterproof jacket, clearly labelled. Alternatively, in case of good weather, please make sure your child has a sun hat and sun cream (if needed) clearly labelled with their name. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink. Farm Kitchen have been notified and therefore will offer a packed lunch option for this day, please go on and book this if you wish to.

The buses will need to depart school at **9:00am** on the morning of the trip and will be back for normal school collection at **3:15pm**. In order to leave at 9.00am, the Foundation Stage gate will be open from 8.40am. It is essential that your child arrives at school **promptly** that day as the bus will not be able to wait for latecomers. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they are given the appropriate medication. If a further tablet is required for the return journey, please place this in a **clearly marked envelope with your child's name and instructions for taking. This should be handed to their class teacher on the morning of the <b>trip.** 

The cost of the trip is £18.20, for which we kindly request a voluntary contribution by Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April at the latest. If for any reason you have difficulty making this payment, please contact the school in confidence. Should sufficient contributions not be received, the trip may be cancelled.

If you are available and would like to join us in visiting the farm park, we would greatly appreciate any help. To ensure the children's safety, we do require a certain number of adults. Please let a member of the Foundation Stage team know if you can join us.
