As part of our science learning around living things and their habitats, all children in Year 4 will be visiting Woodside Wildlife Park just outside of Lincoln on **Tuesday 18th June**. This will be an exciting opportunity to learn even more about some of our planet's most fascinating creatures and how they adapt to survive in their natural habitats.

Children will travel to the Wildlife Park via coach, leaving school at **9am** and will return before the end of the school day. **Therefore, it is important that children arrive at school on time in the morning.**
