## Science: Growing Up

**Survive** - to stay alive.

**Insect** - a small six-legged animal with body in three parts and often with wings.

**Mammal** - an animal that is covered in hair or fur; the female gives birth to live young and feeds her babies on milk from her own body.

**Diet** - the kind of food an animal usually eats.

**life cycle** - the series of changes in the life of an animal from birth to death.

**Christening** - a Christian ceremony signifying the giving of a name.

**Baptism** - a Christian ceremony signifying spiritual cleansing and rebirth.

**Dedication**— committing yourself to something.

**Community** - a group of people living in a particular local area.

**Belonging** - is a sense of fitting in or being a member of a group.

**Festivals** - a period of time set aside for celebrating.

**Map** - a drawing of all or parts of the earth's surface.

**Globe** - a 3D model of the earth.
