PE

We will be developing our athletics skills when working on our throwing, jumping and running. We will also be preparing and practising for sports day.

English

Our writing will be based on the texts, 'Fire of London' and 'A walk in London' this term. We will be writing our own diaries, as well as letters and a London guide.

In reading, we will be developing our fluency and comprehension skills through either Little Wandle texts or reading the books 'Grimwood' and 'The Street Beneath My Feet'. Everyday, we will share a class story with the children.

DT

We will be learning how to build strong structures for a purpose. We will learn how to strengthen a structure using triangles, choose appropriate resources and adapt our ideas.

Outdoor Learning

We shall be learning how to build and light a campfire. We will also be learning and singing campfire songs to sing around the fire.

History

We will be learning about "The Great Fire of London". We will identify and order key events and discuss how the events changed London today.

Maths

We will be focusing on:

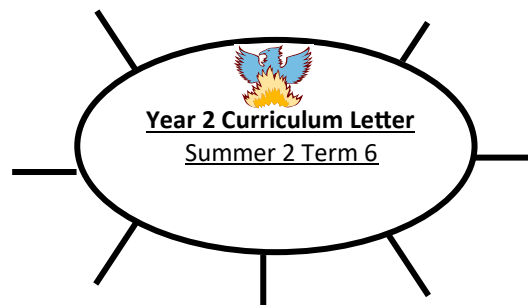
- position and Direction
