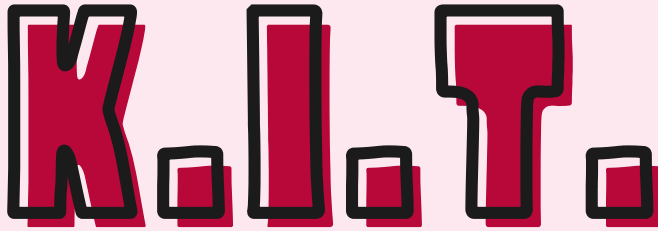

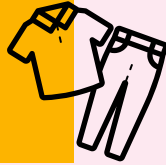

CARE VALUES AND UNIFORM

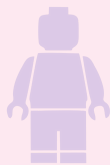
