Dear Parents,

I am writing to share an **important reminder about safety** outside school during **drop-off and pick-up** times.

On Friday, we had an incident in which a carer was knocked to the floor after children were running and playing near the school entrance. An ambulance had to attend, which was understandably distressing for everyone involved. While accidents can happen, this one highlights how vital it is that the area around the school remains calm and safe at these busy times.

To help prevent further accidents, please can we ensure that **children do not:**

- ride scooters or bikes
- run, chase, or play games

The space outside school is not designed for play, and even a small amount of running or scootering can quickly create unsafe situations when so many people are arriving or leaving at once.

We kindly ask all parents and carers to closely supervise their children while waiting. Your support makes a huge difference in keeping everyone safe, and we appreciate your support in looking after our school community.
