



Dear parents and carers,

We are delighted to provide details of the clubs that are available during terms 5 and 6.

Clubs will **start week commencing Monday 27th April 2026** and **finish week ending Friday 17th July 2026**

This summer term, **we are only offering paid-for after school clubs** using our external provider, Boston United FC.

The after school club booking system will be live via MCAS from **9am Wednesday 1st April**. You will find the clubs section in your app and the options available for the appropriate year group your child is in. The clubs are available on a first-come first-serve basis and **will need to be paid** for in order to reserve a space for your child. The booking system will close once all spaces have been filled and paid for. There will be an option for your child to be added to the waiting list should we have any spaces available throughout the term. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that your child will be allocated to a club this term.

IMPORTANT

Once clubs have started, please contact the school office to inform us if your child will not be attending their club for any reason. A register of children present will be completed at the beginning of each session so that we know who is still on the premises. If your child is absent from the club and we have not been informed, a member of staff will contact you to confirm the reason for absence. This is important in certain situations (for example, in case of fire.)

BEHAVIOUR

Any child not maintaining the standards of behaviour and respect that we expect at our school will be given an initial warning by their class teacher with a conversation had with parents. If the behaviour continues, the child will be removed from the session and no longer allowed to attend for the remainder of the term.
