Personal Emotional Social Development

Circle Time sessions will be based around:

- Respect
- Positive attitudes
- Collaboration and teamwork
- Equality
- The importance of looking after the environment, including recycling

Mathematics

- Counting—larger sets and things that cannot be seen
- Subitising to 6, including structured arrangements
- Composition—'5 and a bit' and 'to 10'
- Comparison

Understanding the World

- Share experiences of Easter
- Learn about the stages of a chick life cycle
- Identify and label the parts of a plant
- Learn about farms - what happens there and how food is grown
- Recognise differences and similarities between farming now and in the past

Communication and language and Literacy

- Daily phonics lessons
- Reading groups (with an adult 3 times a week)
- Focus stories - The Little Red Hen and Jack and the Beanstalk.

Physical Development

- Throwing, catching and kicking a ball to themselves, a partner and at a target
- Sports Day practise - staying in the lanes, running, jumping, sack racing

Expressive Arts and Design

- Learn about the process of making bread and make some of their own
- Learn how to use split pins
- Make pictures using different materials
- Explore ways of making different textures
