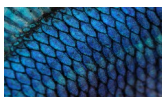
Here you will find some key vocabulary linked to our learning over the term. Please help your child to understand and familiarise themselves with these words and definitions. Thank you for your continued support.

## Science

**Claw**- a sharp nail on the foot of an animal. E.g. cat, dog



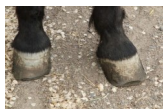
**Scales**- small stiff plates that cover much of the body of animals such as fish and snakes



**Paws**- the foot of an animal that has claws or nails



**Hooves**- covers and protects the feet of certain animals. E.g. horse



**Beak**- the hard, pointed part of a bird's mouth



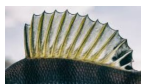
**Feathers**- soft, light things that cover a bird's body



**Fur**- the thick hair that covers the bodies of some animals



**Fin**- a thin vertical part sticking out of the body of fish, dolphins etc.



**Wings**- the two parts of its body that it uses for flying.



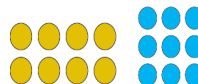
## Maths

**Equal groups**- groups that have the same amount



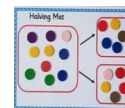
**Total**- the whole amount

**Arrays**- an arrangement of objects, pictures, or numbers in columns or rows



**Doubling**- adding the same number to itself so it is twice as large (i.e.  $2 + 2$ ,  $5 + 5$ ,  $10 + 10$ )

**Halving**- sharing an amount (the whole) into two equal parts/ groups



**Grouping**- making groups of an equal amount



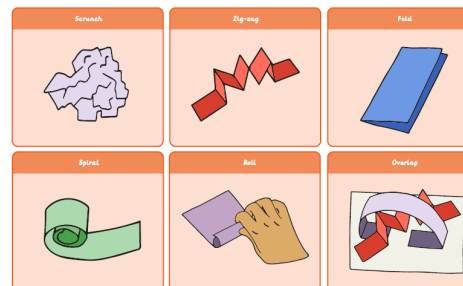
## Art

**Cylinder** - A tube shape

**Detail** - Extra decoration or items that add interest

**Sculpture** - Art in three dimensions; walk all around it to look at it.

**Three dimensional (3D)** - A solid shape; art that isn't flat on paper.



## Geography/ History

**Sea**- a large area of salty water that is surrounded by land



**Beach**- an area of sand or stones beside the sea



**Coast**- an area of land that is next to the sea



**Cliff**- a high area of land with a very steep side next to the sea



**Lighthouse**- a tall building near the coast, with a flashing light on the top to warn ships of rocks and other dangers



**Pier**- a platform on pillars above the sea



**Promenade**- a wide path for walking on near the sea



**Bathing machine**- a hut on wheels that was pulled into the sea and used for changing in



**Grace Darling**- a lighthouse keeper's daughter born in 1815. She is remembered for the rescue she undertook with her father, saving the lives of survivors from a shipwreck in 1838
