## Geography

**River Zambezi** - A river that runs through Zambia.

**Nshima**—A staple food in Zambia. A thick porridge made from maize flour.

**Victoria Falls**—A huge waterfall located on the Zambezi river.

**Lusaka**—A city. The capital of Zambia.

**Market Stall**— A structure used by merchants to display and their merchandise.

**Mugurameno**—A small village in Zambia.

## Art

**Impressing**— when marks are made by pressing tools, objects and materials into clay.

**Join**— when you attach pieces of clay together.

**Pinch pot**— is a simple pot made by pinching clay with your hand.

**Sculptor**—an artist who creates sculptures.

**Sculpture**— is a piece of art work which is 3D.

**Score**— is when you scratch the clay as part of the joining process.

**Slip**— is a clay slurry which sticks pieces of clay together like a glue.

## Science: Seeds and bulbs

**Flower**—the part of a plant which is often coloured other than green and grows above the ground.

**Roots**—the part of a plant which grows under the ground

**Seed**—a plant part from which a new plant grows

**Stem**—the part of a plant which grows above the ground and which holds the leaves and flowers

**Bulb**—a rounded structure which acts as a food store; a new plant will sprout and grow from it

## PSHE: Health and Wellbeing

**Medicine** - something that treats an illness.

**Oral Hygiene** - to keep your mouth clean.

**Feelings** - an emotional reaction to something.
