Geography— Amazon Basin

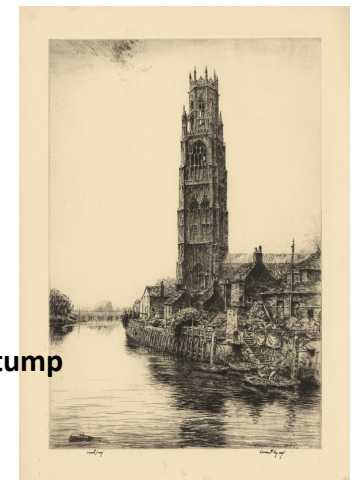
A n Basin	The world's largest drainage basin and tropical rainforest. It is in South America.
Agriculture	Farming.
Ecosystem	A community of living organisms interacting with each other and their non-living physical environment.
Humidity	The amount of water vapour present in the air which indicates the likelihood of fog, dew or precipitation.
River basin	The area of land drained by a river and its tributaries.
Equatorial	The hot, wet climate in areas close to the Equator.
Prime Meridian	The earth's longitudinal line running north-south.
Tropic of Capricorn	A circle of latitude that passes through South America where the sun can be directly overhead at noon.
Western Hemisphere	The half of the earth West of the Prime Meridian.

History—The Hansa Traders

Imported	To bring goods in to a place from a foreign source so that they can be bought.
Exported	To take goods out of a place to a foreign place in order to sell them.
Trade	To buy and sell goods.
Heanseatic League	European merchants— people who buy and sell goods for profit in the late 13th Century (late
