History

Migration— the movement from one place to another.

Refugee— a person who is forced to leave their country due to war, persecution or natural disaster.

Migrant - a person who moves from place to another.

Immigration— to live permanently in a different country to the one you were born in.

Emigration - the intention of leaving the country you are born in to move to another country.

Persecution - to be treated poorly and unfairly based on your ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or political beliefs.

Science: Living things and their habitats

Life cycle - the different stages of a living thing.

Reproduce - the process where offspring of any living thing are produced.

Sexual reproduction - offspring produced by a male and female parent.

Asexual reproduction - offspring is produced by only one parent that has the same genetic information as its parent.

Plantlets— A young plant.

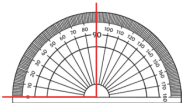
Runners— A horizontal stem that smaller plants grow from and develop roots.

Cuttings— a small part of a plant which is cut off to grow into a new plant.

Maths

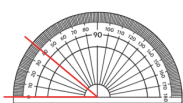
Right Angle

A right angle is 90° .



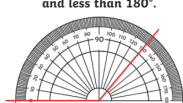
Acute Angle

An acute angle is less than 90° .



Obtuse Angle

An obtuse angle is more than 90° and less than 180° .



Reflex Angle

A reflex angle is greater than 180° and less than 360° .
