Year 4 Yorkshire Wildlife Park Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Tuesday 30th June**, we will be taking all the children in Year 4 to **Yorkshire Wildlife Park**. The trip will support the children's science learning during Summer Term 2. The children will be supervised by a Boston West member of staff to explore the wildlife park as a group having the opportunity to see animals from across the globe (such as polar bears, tigers and red pandas). In the afternoon, the children will take part in a lesson led by one of the park team members about endangered animal classification (which are only available for schools to take part in). The lesson involves giving the children the opportunity to see and touch animal-related items and also some live animals!

The cost of the trip will be **£22 per child**, which includes the coach, lesson and entrance to the park itself. We ask for a voluntary contribution to be paid to the school by **Friday 5th June**. This will be found in the outstanding payments section on the MCAS app. If for any reason you have difficulty making this payment, please contact the school in confidence. Should sufficient contributions not be received, the trip may be cancelled.

The coach will be leaving promptly at **8:15am** therefore you will need to ensure your child **arrives at school by 8:05am**. Year 4 staff will be available from **7:50am** to allow the children plenty of time to arrive at school. The children will enter school from the normal year 4 gate. The coach will be leaving the park at 2.30pm with the aim to **arrive back at school by 4pm**.

Please make sure your child has a packed lunch and a drink, a school trip packed lunch option will be available with Ideal School Meals. All children must wear **School uniform** for this trip, please also ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions of the day.

No money is required as there will not be time to visit the gift shop.
