Jill Fred The friends Narrators	Everyday children's clothing and shoes e.g. jeans and a top.
Alexa	An outfit with a bit of sparkle!
Grandma	Chintzy, old-fashioned clothes.
Grandad	Dark school trousers, a shirt and a walking stick.
Victorian children	Boys – school shorts, white school top or shirt, waistcoat. (no logos) Girls – white short or top. (no logos)
Teacher	Formal dress and a black cape (think graduation gown!)
Egyptians	Dark trousers and a plain white or black t-shirt.
Mummy	Plain, dark clothes (no logos). Costume provided by school.
Vikings	Dark trousers and plain black or white t-shirt. A Viking hat if you have one! Accessories provided by school.
Queen Elizabeth	Costume provided by school. White face make-up.
Ladies in waiting/ Anny Boleyn	Costume provided by school.
Walter Raleigh	Dark trousers and a shirt. An Elizabethan style hat (think velvet and a feather!) if you have one!
Elizabethan gentlemen	Dark trousers and a shirt.
Nurses	Long, dark dress or skirt with a plain white top.
Soldiers	Any appropriate WW1 soldier outfit e.g. camouflage, greens, browns, boots etc.

Props – plastic swords, Viking hats, soldier uniforms, Egyptian costumes, nurse costumes, stethoscopes/ medical items.
