Year 1 Skegness Aquarium trip – Tuesday 14th July 2026

Dear parents and carers,

To support our learning in history, geography and science, we have organised a trip for both classes to visit Skegness Aquarium on Tuesday 14th July. Each class will spend time exploring the aquarium, they will have a Tank Talk and will also spend time in the Jurassic Falls Dinoland. There will also be time before classes depart to have fun on Skegness beach and to recap learning about what seashores were like in the past compared to now.

All children **must wear their school uniform for the trip, depending on the weather, they should also bring either a coat or a sun hat.**

They will also need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. A pack lunch option will be available to order through Ideal School Meals.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they are given the appropriate medication. If a further tablet is required for the return journey, please place this **in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and instructions for taking. This should be handed to their class teacher on the morning of the trip.**

The coach will need to **depart from school at 9am** on the morning of the trip. It is essential that your child arrives at school promptly at 8:45am, as the children will need to go to the toilet prior to leaving and the bus will not wait for latecomers. We will return to school by the usual collection time of 3:15pm.

The cost of the trip is **£11.30 per child**, for which we kindly request a voluntary contribution **by Friday 27th June.** (You will find the payment request in the outstanding payment section on your MCAS app) If for any reason you have difficulty making this payment, please contact the school, in confidence. Should sufficient contributions not be received, the trip will be cancelled.

To be able to go on the trip, we will need a few volunteers to join us. If you or a relative are able to help, please let one of the Year 1 teachers know. You will need to read a risk assessment, be physically fit/well enough to come on the trip and help supervise the children. We will confirm with you nearer the time, whether you have a place on the trip.
