This vocabulary bank shows key vocabulary that we will be sharing with your child over Term 6.

We are continuing with our history themed topic of 'Local History'

Please go through the words on this vocabulary bank with your child to help familiarise them with the vocabulary. Some of it is the same as before but will continue to be looked at. We will also share this throughout the term and during our relevant lessons.

Science:

Burr—a prickly seed vessel that attaches to animals

Carpel—female part of the flower

Flower—colourful part of plant that attracts pollinators

Germinate— when a seed begins to grow

Ovary— female reproductive part of a flower

Ovule —the female part of a flower that produces the seed after pollination

Petal—a modified, brightly coloured leaf

Pollen— fine, powdery substance made by the male part of the plant

Pollination— transfer of pollen from the female part of a flower to the male part

Seed—the part that develops once pollination has occurred

Sepal— a petal that protects the developing flower bud

Stamen—male part of the flower

Attach— Join or fasten one or more object.
