Maths

Please support your children with practising the 2,5,10 times tables as we begin to look at the 3s. We shall also count forwards and backwards.

We will be focusing on:

- ◇ Place Value
- ◇ Addition and subtraction

English

Please continue to support with your child's reading by listening to them read regularly and asking questions about what they have read. Our writing this term will be focused on narratives.

In Reading, we shall continue to focus on our fluency using EARS whilst looking at adventure stories and poetry.

Science

Our focus area is Rocks and Soils. Children will be sorting rocks based on their properties, understanding the process of how fossils were made and looking at what soil is made from.

PSHE

We shall be learning about the importance of family and relationships.

MfL (French)

This term, we will begin learning French by looking at greetings and expressing how we feel in French.

Geography

We shall be discovering the journey that our food makes from the farm to our fork and the distance that some foods travel to end up on our plate.

Computing

This term we will be using our programming skills to create a sequence, exploring inputs and outputs.
