Art

This term, we will investigate the style and characteristics of Ancient Egyptian art. We will use skills inspired by this to create our own 'Egyptian' artwork using pencil, paint and clay.

Maths

In our maths sessions, we will be focusing on:

- Place value of numbers up to 4,000
- Rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1,000
- Adding and subtracting two 4-digit numbers
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History

This term, we will be starting to learn about the Ancient Egyptians. We will develop our understanding of chronology, use historical sources to find out about the past and use maps from the past to consider how Egypt has changed.

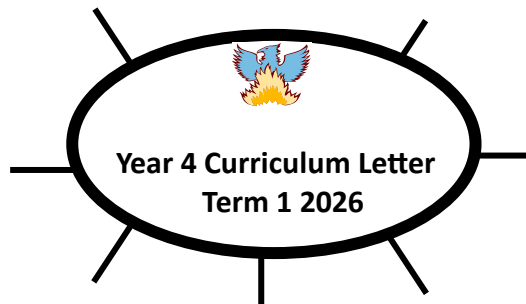
English

After exploring this term's writing texts 'Frindleswyde' and 'The Wild Robot', we will be writing our own poems and narratives. Over the term, we will also be honing our application of grammar and spelling rules.

In reading sessions, we will be developing our understanding of the features of non-fiction texts, through our study of the text 'Skygazing.' We will also be working to improve our fluency and stamina when reading the narrative text 'Wild Robot.'

PSHE

We will be learning about positive friendships whilst developing strategies for resolving conflict. We will develop our understanding of respectful online communication and consider when it is right to keep a secret.



PE

We will be developing our ball control, attacking and defending skills when playing handball. Our PE day will be **Thursdays**.

Outdoor Learning

This term we will be preparing planters for Autumn and whittling sticks.

Science

Our scientific focus this term is on understanding humans' impact on the environment. We will find out about the impact of litter and pollution, as well as investigating how materials decompose.

Geography

This term, our learning will be focused on the United Kingdom. We will be learning about the countries, regions and human and physical features of the UK as well renewable energy which will link to our trip to FCC North Hykeham in November (more information to follow).
