Music

This term we will be developing melodic phrases and investigating how music brings us altogether.

English

Our text types this term are:

- ✧ Narrative
- ✧ War Poetry
- ✧ Instructional Writing

We are also going to be developing our reading comprehension skills and our grammatical knowledge.

Art

During our lessons we will be exploring art with a message, looking at the works of Pablo Picasso and Käthe Kollwitz and through the mediums of graffiti, drawing, painting and sculpture, creating artworks with a message.

PSHE

We will be looking at safe relationships before developing our understanding about how the news and media show information in different ways, focusing on propaganda during WW2.

History

During this term our main topic focus is The Mayans. We will be looking at the history of this ancient civilisation and discovering what day to day life was like for these jungle-dwelling people.

Geography

Our lessons will focus around map skills, longitude and latitude, time zones. We will also be focusing on climate and how this differs

Science

Our focus areas for this term are:

- › Light
- › Electricity

DT

The children will have an opportunity to design, make and evaluate their own Victorian fairground attraction. They will also be using their knife skills to create Christmas themed food.

PE

The children will be taking part in a range of activities that develop and explore different areas of their health and fitness. Children will learn different components of fitness including speed, stamina, strength, co-ordination, balance and agility.

Maths

We will be learning:

- › to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals and integers
- › To identify the place value of numbers up to 10,000,000
- › to use our skills to solve problems
- › to identify number sequences
- › how fractions, decimals and percentages connect

Computing

This term, we will be learning how to 3D model using the Tinkercad app. We will be planning, developing, and evaluating 3D computer models of physical objects as well as creating 3D models of our own. We will also be exploring variables when coding and designing a game.

RE

We will be focussing on the rites of passage within the religion of Christianity.

MfL (French)

This term, we will be:

- › reviewing and recapping past learning and previously taught vocabulary.
- › France and its culture.
