PARKING AND SITE SAFETY REMINDER

- Families with a valid Blue Badge are able to use the car park but should discuss this with the school beforehand.
- All adults and children should use the designated footpaths and paved areas at all times.
- Children leaving through the main car park gates at the end of the day should move directly onto the paved area and follow the designated pathway.
- Bikes and scooters should **not** be ridden anywhere on the school site.

For the safety of all pupils, staff may politely challenge any unauthorised use of the car park. This is not about causing inconvenience, but about ensuring the site remains safe and accessible for everyone.
